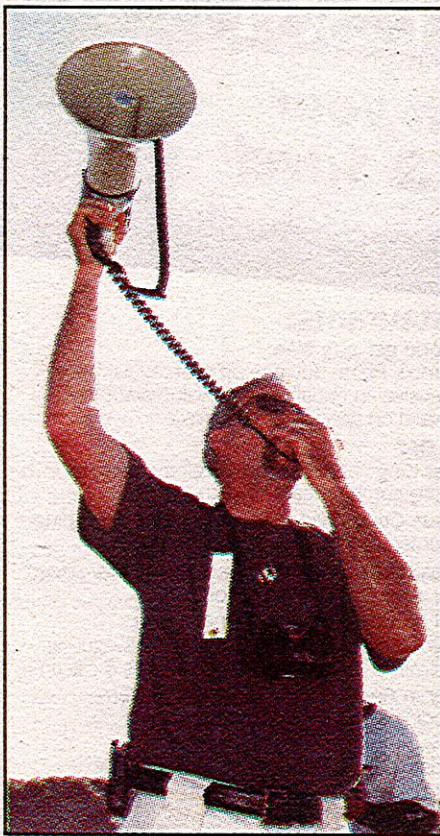
Female 40 to 49 — Third place, Muffy Johnson, Morro Bay.

Male 60 and above — First place, Jim Murray, Los Osos; second place, Bill Garrett, Morro Bay; third place, Frank Spade, Morro Bay.

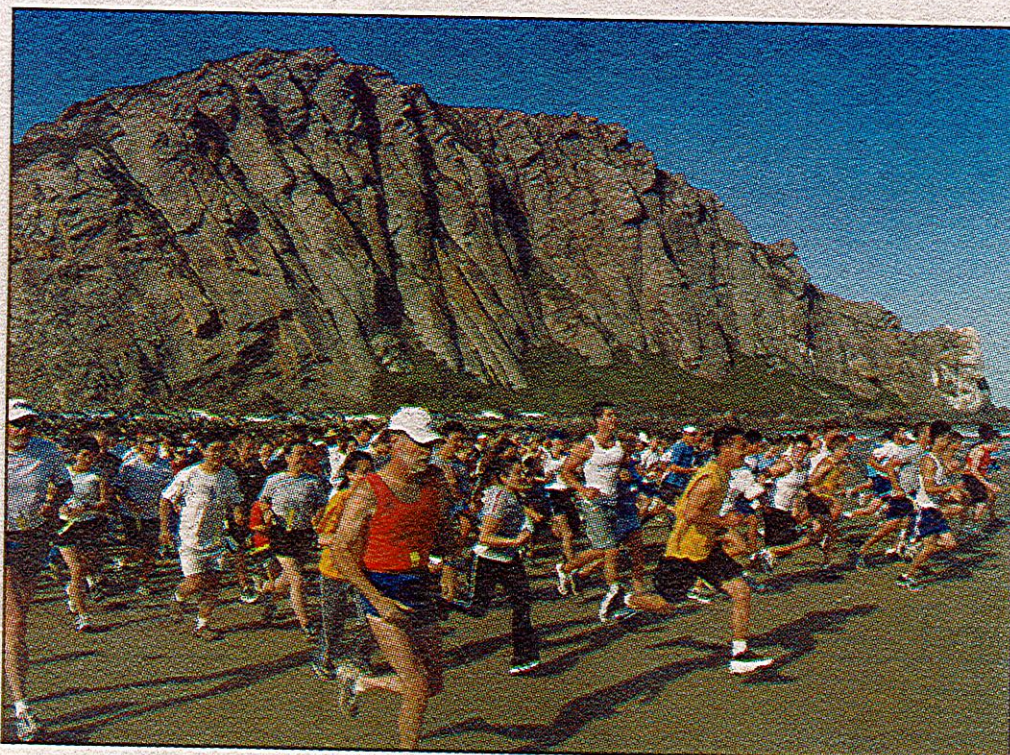
