- ✓ Participate in 24/7 after-hours on-call rotation (usually 1 week every 8-12 weeks)

- ✓ Meet all state criminal record & health screening clearance requirements and have a valid CA driver's license, insurance & acceptable DMV record

BASIC DUTIES:

- ✓ Provide case management & social work services, including: case assessment & treatment planning, progress reports and evaluations, scheduling of required appointments, parent support & training, maintaining regular case notes of client and agency activities & attending multi-disciplinary treatment team or similar meetings.
- ✓ Provide mental health services, including: assessment, child and family team meetings, individual, group & family therapy, rehabilitation, brokerage & crisis intervention. Some or all may be MediCal billed.
- ✓ Provide transitional living services including lifeskill assessment and skill development in critical life domains.
- ✓ May supervise In-home support or youth development staff.
